

ANNEX 2: SECTOR CATEGORISATION BY LEGAL TYPE

We have four key categories for segmenting types of organisations as users of the tool. The first three (NGO, Public Sector and Universities) are non-commercial organisations and are therefore combined in the analysis for the 'Not-for-Profit' sector.

1. NGO (NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANISATIONS)

For UK based organisations:

- Trust
- Scottish Charitable Incorporated Organisation
- Royal Charter
- Registered Society
- PRI/LTD BY GUAR/NSC (Private, limited by guarantee, no share capital)
- PRI/LBG/NSC (Private, limited by guarantee, no share capital, use of 'limited' exemption)
- Constitution
- Community Interest Company
- Charitable Incorporated Organisation (in England or Wales).

For non-UK based organisations:

- NGO (non-UK validated non-government or commercial entity with social mission)

2. PUBLIC SECTOR

- Public Sector (apparently a government entity)
- Academy Trust (a type of public education provider in England)

3. UNIVERSITY

Validated by url/website

4. COMMERCIAL

- Public Limited Company
- Private Limited Company
- Commercial (non-UK validated commercial)
